The following policy has been adopted for the cultivation, processing, and possession of medical marijuana under the Compassionate Use Act in El Dorado County. Absent evidence of sales, persons who have the recommendation or approval of a physician to use marijuana or their primary caregivers will not be prosecuted if they conform to these guidelines.

OUTDOOR GROWS

Marijuana may be grown in an area no greater than 200 square feet provided that the area is fully enclosed by a solid, opaque fence that is a minimum of six and a maximum of eight feet in height. There is no limitation on the number on the number of plants which may be grown within the 200 square foot area.

INDOOR GROWS

20 marijuana plants in the flowering stage, 20 plants in the clone/vegetative state and one mother plant.

Patients or primary caregivers may not have both an outdoor and indoor grow at the same time.

Neither indoor nor outdoor grows may be within a 600-foot radius of a school.

PROCESSED MARIJUANA

Patients and/or primary caregivers may possess two pounds of processed marijuana.
