

## Concentrated Cannabis in El Dorado County

We are hearing from young, frightened, vulnerable qualified medical marijuana patients that are being targeted and stopped by El Dorado County Sheriff's deputies and Placerville CHP officers and told that -"El Dorado County does not allow concentrated cannabis."

Please let us know of any occasion in which the officer takes your medicine without citation, or cites or arrests you for possession of cannabis concentrate. 530-677-5362

Yes, there is a legal issue with manufacturing concentrated cannabis produced in an unregulated environment with dangerous chemicals, but possession of concentrated cannabis, 11357(A) HSC, by qualified patients is specifically protected by SB 420 and by the 2003 California Attorney General Opinion 03-411 - "Concentrated cannabis or hashish is included within the meaning of medical marijuana as that term is used in the Compassionate Use Act of 1996."
