

Supes Vote to Allow Pre-existing Dispensaries

The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors voted to allow existing dispensing collectives to continue operations, with 60 days to document their continuous existence six months prior to the October 30, 2011 "urgency" ordinance restricting "new dispensaries". The BOS went even later into the evening to reach a final determination on the particulars of the outdoor cultivation ordinance.
